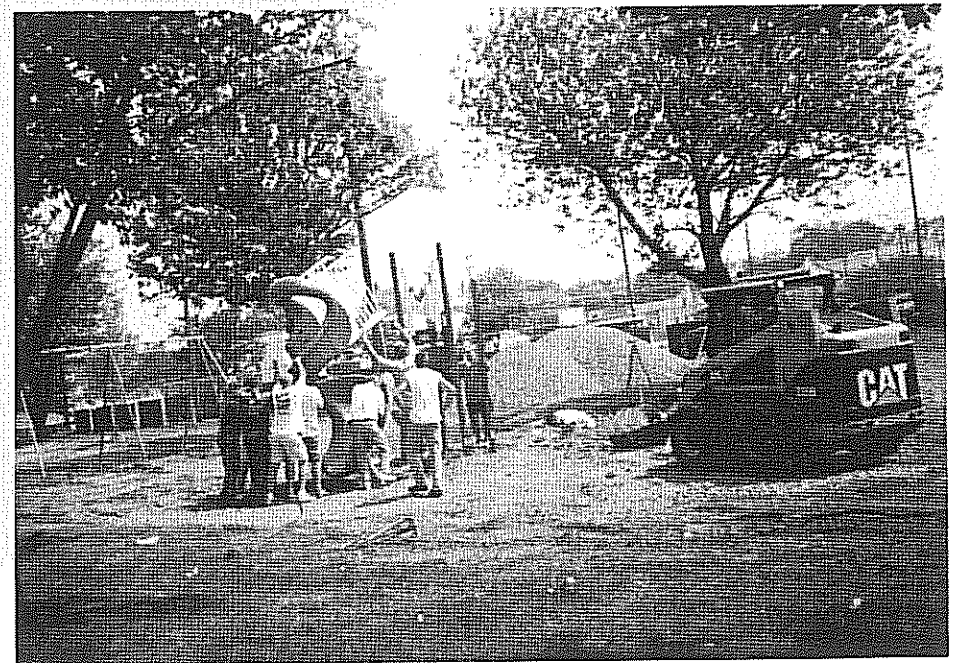

## RESOLUTION No. 02 of 2008

A Resolution of the Borough of Dupont, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania prohibiting the use of tobacco in outdoor parks and recreational facilities.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Dupont believes that tobacco use in the proximity of children and adults engaging in or watching outdoor recreational activities at Borough owned or operated parks is detrimental to their health and can be offensive to those using such facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Dupont has a unique opportunity to create and sustain an environment that supports a non-tobacco norm through tobacco-free policy, rule enforcement, and adult-peer modeling on Borough owned outdoor parks and recreational facilities; and

WHEREAS, the tobacco industry sponsors and advertises at recreational events to foster a connection between tobacco use and recreation; and

WHEREAS, cigarettes, once consumed in public spaces, are often discarded on the ground, requiring additional maintenance expenses diminishing the beauty of the Borough's Parks and Recreational facilities will serve to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Borough.

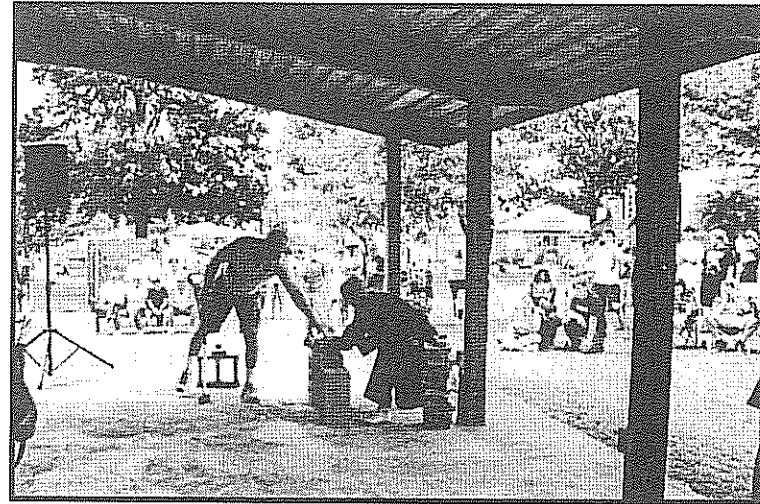
